

Professor Emeritus Panayiotis C. Ioakimidis

P. C. Ioakimidis is Professor Emeritus of European Integration at the University of Athens. He has also been Visiting Professor at the Hellenic School of Public Administration (Athens), the Centre for Diplomatic Studies of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs (Athens), the NATO Defence College (Rome) and other academic institutions. He has lectured widely on European Union issues in Europe and the USA.

He served as an adviser (Ambassador/Councilor) on European Union Affairs to the Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs and to the Prime Minister, C. Simitis. In this capacity, he took part in all major EU treaty negotiations, including the negotiations for the Single European Act, the Treaty of Maastricht and the Treaty of Amsterdam. He was the Greek Representative to the Intergovernmental Conference for the Nice Treaty (2000) and Alternate Member to the European Convention to draw up a European Constitution (2002-2003).

Professor Ioakimidis served for years as President of the Governing Board and General Director of the Hellenic Centre for European Studies (EKEM) as well as a member of the Governing Board of the Hellenic Foundation for European and Foreign Policy (ELIAMEP) and is currently member of the Governing Board of the Association for the Modernisation of the Greek Society (OPEK).
